- 1. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all certified Delaware State USBC members who observe the USBC rules. This includes all adult members from any Delaware local association. (Must be sanctioned in a Delaware Association before the tournament starts).
- 2. **Events:** This tournament will consist of: Doubles, Singles and Team
- a. Team consists of 4 bowlers, any combination of men and women.
- b. Doubles/Singles Bowlers competing in the doubles event must also compete in singles and vice-versa.
- 3. **Optional Events:** Virtual events are open to all bowlers. Bowlers wishing to have their scores count towards these awards must pay additional fees. (See Rule 13 for breakdown). <u>Handicap All-Events will be broken into Division 1 & Division 2.</u>
- 4. **Multiple Entries:** Multiple entries are permitted. First scores bowled in each event will count towards your All-Event's Total. (Entries are reserved on a first come, first served basis).
- a. Team Event Unlimited entries permitted provided two
 (2) or more bowlers in the lineup are different.
- b. Doubles Event- Unlimited entries permitted provided you bowl with a different partner each time.
 - c. Singles Event- Unlimited entries permitted.
- 5. **Official Tournament Entries:** Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. Failure to use the proper average, or make a correction **PRIOR** to the completion of the first game bowled will resulting disqualification, (USBC Rule 319) Average to be used in this tournament will be determined in the following order.
 - a. Entrants shall use their highest certified average established in any USBC certified league from the 2018-2019 season (winter & summer)based on 21 games or more.
 - b. If no 18-19 book avg, then bowler will use current season avg as of March 31, 2020 for 21 games or more per USBC rule 319a-1. Must provide current avg sheet for all leagues.
 - c. **Ten Pin Rule:** If you're current 2019-2020 Avg, with 21 or more games is 10 pins higher than last year's average, you must use your current average in this tournament. (USBC rule 319). This current average includes substitution averages.
 - d. All other bowlers must bowl scratch (240).
 - e. Rule 319c will not be used.
 - f. **Prize Reporting:** Bowlers who have qualified for \$600.00 or more in any tournament event or division of an event during 12 months prior to the time of entry, must attach a repost of money won in every case. Re-rating average (Rule 319d) will not be used
- 6. **Handicap:** Percentage of handicap will be 90%; of 240 singles and all events, 90% of 480 doubles, and 90% of 960.
- 7. **Substitutions:** Report all substitutes to the Tournament Manager at least 45 minutes prior to bowling.
- a. Once a substitute throws their first ball for score, they must finish that event.
- 8. **Refunds & Rescheduling:** No refunds will be permitted after squad is confirmed. However, in the event of an emergency, we will reschedule if possible

- 9. **Check In:** Individuals must check in at least 30 minutes prior to squad time. Average & address verification must be submitted /confirmed.
- 10. **Scoring:** Once an event begins and a bowler is not there when it's their turn to bowl, a zero will be credited for every frame missed
- a. Automatic score sheets will be used as the official score sheet.
- b. Bowlers must certify their scores as being correct at the completion of scores bowled. This will be the only opportunity for corrections.
- 11. **Awards:** All awards are based on handicap score in each event. (Except for Optional Scratch Events)
- a. Prize fund returned 100% at a ratio of a minimum of 1 for every 5 entries per event.
- b. 1st place finishers of each Handicap event will also receive a Championship award.
- 12. **Protests:** The tournament mgr. will handle all protests. Tournament mgr. has the authority to accept or reject any entrant. All appeals will be handled in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 13. **Entry Fees:** Each actual bowling event costs \$30.00 per bowler, per event.
