TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. All USBC tournament rules and regulations will govern: Tournament is open to Youth League Coaches; Northern Delaware, Lower Delaware, and Delaware State Board Members; Youth League Volunteers; Youth League Officers (Adult and Youth); & Junior Coaches Only.
 - a. Participants must be at least 14 years old as of August 1st, 2019.
 - b. Teams must consist of at least 1 adult bowler.
- 2. Averages will be done in the following order
 - a. Highest USBC Book Average from 2018-2019 season
 - b. Highest USBC league average (Min. 21 games) as of and including December 25, 2019
 - c. If no average, then: Men 200 & Women 150.

Please forward all average sheets with entry form and payment. Bowlers who bowl in more than one league must list all league averages on back or bottom of the entry form and provide average sheets for all leagues. No entries accepted without payment and average sheets.

- 3. Individual Handicap is 90% of 240.
- 4. All errors must be reported within 24 hours. The tournament director will be the final authority. Errors in handicap will be automatically corrected.
- 5. Late bowlers receive zero (0) for frames missed. Once a replacement has bowled the first ball of the first frame, the substitution stands.
- 6. No smoking or drinking alcohol during competition.
- 7. Dress Code: Participants in the Tournament must be neat in appearance and meet the following dress code rules:
 - a. Shirts Participants should wear shirts to represent their bowling center.
- 8. Winning team will get to choose which center they would like the tournament to be held in the following year. The tournament cannot be held in the same center 2 years in a row. *TIES*: If a tie occurs for first place, a one game roll off will be used to break the tie.
