### DSUSBC TOURNAMENT RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. **Eligibility:** This tournament is open to all certified Delaware State USBC members who observe the USBC rules. This includes all adult members from any Delaware local association. (Must be sanctioned in a Delaware Association before the tournament starts).
- 2. **Events:** This tournament will consist of: Doubles and Singles.
- **a**. Doubles/Singles Bowlers competing in singles and doubles these are now separate events and you are not required to bowl in both events.
- 3. **Optional Events:** Virtual events are open to all bowlers. Bowlers wishing to have their scores count towards these awards must pay additional fees. (See Rule 13 for breakdown). <u>Handicap</u> All-Events will be broken into Division 1 & Division 2.
- 4. **Multiple Entries:** Multiple entries are permitted. First scores bowled in each event will count towards your All-Event's Total. (Entries are reserved on a first come, first served basis).
- a. Doubles Event- Unlimited entries permitted provided you bowl with a different partner each time.
- b. Singles Event- Unlimited entries permitted.
- 5. **Official Tournament Entries:** Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average. Failure to use the proper average, or make a correction **PRIOR** to the completion of the first game bowled will resulting disqualification, (USBC Rule 319) Average to be used in this tournament will be determined in the following order.
  - a. Entrants shall use their highest certified average established in any USBC certified league from the 2021-2022 season (winter & summer) based on 21 games.
  - b. If no 2021-2022 book avg, then bowler will use current season avg as of April 1, 2023 for 21 games or more per USBC rule 319a-1. Must provide current avg sheet for all leagues.
  - c. **Ten Pin Rule:** If you're current 2022-2023 Avg, with 21 or more games is 10 pins higher than your book average, you must use your current average in this tournament. (USBC rule 319). This current average includes substitution averages.
  - d. All other bowlers must bowl scratch (220).
  - e. Rule 319c will not be used.
  - f. **Prize Reporting:** Bowlers who have qualified for \$300.00 or more prize funds in any single event or; \$500 or more in any one tournament in total or; \$1000 or more combined in tournaments during the past 12 months prior to the time of entry, must attach a report of money won in every case. See USBC Rule 319d for details on full reporting requirements.
- 6. **Handicap:** Percentage of handicap will be 90%; of 220 singles and 90% of 440 for doubles.
- 7. **Substitutions:** Report all substitutes to the Tournament Manager at least 45 minutes prior to bowling.
- a. Once a substitute throws their first ball for score, they must finish that event.
- 8. **Refunds & Rescheduling:** No refunds will be permitted after squad is confirmed. However, in the event of an emergency, we will reschedule if possible

- 9. **Check In:** Individuals must check in at least 30 minutes prior to squad time. Average & address verification must be submitted /confirmed.
- 10. **Scoring:** Once an event begins and a bowler is not there when it's their turn to bowl, a zero will be credited for every frame missed.
- a. Automatic score sheets will be used as the official score sheet
- b. Bowlers must certify their scores as being correct at the completion of scores bowled. This will be the only opportunity for corrections.
- 11. **Awards:** All awards are based on handicap score in each event. (Except for Optional Scratch Events)
- a. Prize fund returned 100% at a ratio of a minimum of 1 for every 5 entries per event.
- b. 1<sup>st</sup> place finishers of each Handicap event will also receive a Championship award.
- 12. **Protests:** The tournament mgr. will handle all protests. Tournament mgr. has the authority to accept or reject any entrant.

- 13. **Entry Fees:** Each actual bowling event costs \$30.00 per bowler, per event.
- 14. Dress Code: Preferred bowling attire consists of a collared "golf" style shirt and casual pants, slacks or jeans (no holes or tears). The following items are not to be worn during competition. Failure to abide by this rule will result in disqualification. This is a State Championship Tournament and should be respected as such.

DRESS CODE: NO TORN JEANS OR JEANS WITH HOLES! NO CUT-OFFS OR BATHING SUITS! NO TANK TOPS OR MUSCLE SHIRTS! ALL PANTS MUST BE WORE AT THE WAIST!!!! SHORTS & SKIRTS MUST BE WITHIN 2 INCHES ABOVE THE KNEE PICTURES MUST BE APPRORIATE CHECK W/DIRECTOR IF UNSURE.
